

## Florida Has Sold Over Million Dollars Worth of Thrift Stamps Since December

Sales for the first eleven days of May show a total of \$140,492.13 worth of War Savings Stamps were disposed of, while the total sales, from Dec. 3, including May 11, were \$1,109,514.57, according to a statement just issued from the State director's office.

This is record sales and indicates to what proportions the sale of stamps has grown in Florida, but as large as it seems, it is far from sufficient to guarantee the State absorbing the remainder of it this year. Sale of stamps up to date should have been about \$6,500,000, and it is for this purpose of adding a great deal of stimulus that the drive will be made during the month of June, culminating in a big pledge day on June 28th, when meetings will be held in every town and hamlet, not only in Florida, but in the United States.
