County Agent's Notes

Sulphate of potash should be used on potatoes, they are smoother than when potash salts containing chlorine is used; tobacco is liable to lower the starch content of Irish and sweet potatoes, hinders crystallization of the sugar in sugar beets, no doubt due to its burning qualities.

For cut worm use the Kansas mixture. If the planting is large, it can be made as follows: A—Bran 20 pounds, cottonseed meal or any equivalent, 51 pounds, Paris Green 1 pound. B—Water 2½ gallons, molasses or syrup 2 quarts, lemons 3 or 4. The lemons should be grated. Mix A and B until decidedly damp, not sloppy, then distribute in small hills over field at sundown. This formula is especially good on cabbage beds.

We notice young growth and bloom galore in the citrus groves. It would be well to look out for thrips and spray with lime sulphur and black leaf 40. This mixture will eradicate countless mite and kill thrip that disfigures our fruit so, more often than not lowering the price.

Best to use the above when 1-3 to 1-2 the petals have fallen off the grapefruit and oranges. Two and one half gallons of Lime Sulphur to 100 gallons of water plus 13 ounces of nicotine sulphate B. L. 40) to 100 gallons of the spray solution.

It is not time to spray with the oils

for white fly, but where a bad infection of scale is prevalent a good spray with any of the oil sprays (Yother formula preferred) for scale is recommended. I do not recommend B. L. 40 added to the oil emulsion.

Better study over the general conditions of your trees and be thinking what fertilizer will be necessary for the June application. You cannot decide at the last minute.

Early blight on the Irish potatoes may show itself at any time and can be told by the roundish brown spots on the leaves, somewhat concentric; bad cases show the leaves shrivelled and dead—spray with Bordeaux 4-4-50 adding a little B. Leaf 40.

Be on the look out for lice or aphids on the young melons and spray at once with Black Leaf 40 as follows: 2 pounds whale oil soap dissolved in 5 gallons water to which add 25 pints of B. L. 40 and heat gently for five minutes. When ready dilute with water to 50 gallons. This is very effective and does the work.

For bud worm in corn, drop into the bud a mixture of 1-2 pound arsenate lead powder and 10 pounds of hydrated or well air slaked lime.

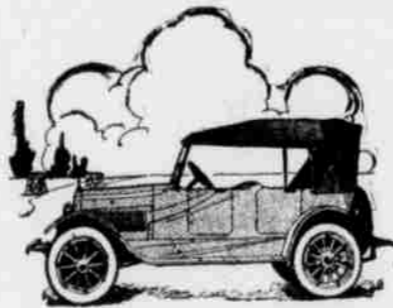
