FOREIGNERS TO VISIT THE U.S.

NUMBER OF BUSINESS MEN ARE DUE IN COUNTRY IN A FEW DAYS

WASHINGTON, November 8.—Two commissions composed of government officials and business men from European countries are expected to reach the United States within the next few days with the primary purpose of reciprocal commercial relations. A commission of French business men, under the leadership of the secretary of the Budget committee of the French chamber of deputies, is now due in New York with the idea of devoting considerable time to a study of general commercial conditions existing in the United States.

It is expected that the commission will visit the leading cities of the country, not only to study American methods of business, but also to extend the interest of Americans in French products and French markets. While the precise itinerary which the commission will follow is not known at present, the bureau of foreign and domestic commerce expects to be in possession of such information shortly after the commission's arrival and will then answer inquiries on the subject.

A similar commission, representing the Amsterdam chamber of commerce is expected to sail from Amsterdam on November 6, reaching the United States about the middle of the month. No definite information as to the course to be followed by this commission is at present available, but it is understood that the commission contemplates going directly to Washington to confer with representatives of the government and of the chamber of commerce of the United States, before making further announcement as to its plans.
