WILHELM IN JERUSALEM Turn Your Back

GERMAN EMPEROR REACHES THE HOLY CITY.

Russia Objects to the Kaiser's Trip as Likely to Undermine the Influence of the Orthodox Greek Church.

JERUSALEM, October 29.—Emperor William and Empress Augusta Victoria with their suites arrived in perfect health at the encampment outside of the town today. At 11 o'clock their majesties entered the Jaffa gate and at 3 o'clock they visited the old Church of the Holy Sepulcher. The streets presented a lively appearance and the buildings were lavishly decorated.

BERLIN, October 29.—Emperor William's visit to the Orient is characterized as an imprudent attempt to undermine Russian influence in Turkey, and the position of the orthodox church in Palestine. The Russian clerical authorities fear German Protestant rule in Jerusalem where orthodox pilgrims are ten times more numerous than those of all other creeds together. It is said that Russia in order to counteract the Anglo-German agreement, will come to a closer understanding with Austria, by which these two countries and France will jointly oppose the increasing influence of Germany in the Orient and in no case will they permit Turkish concessions to Germany.

HAWAII ON CANVASS.

Oils and Water Colors by McComas and Blaschki.

McComas and Blaschki, the two Australian artists who have spent some time in Honolulu leave for America on Wednesday by the Moana. These parties have for the last few weeks confined themselves to the charms of Moanalua, and have depicted it in a way which shows their earnestness and appreciation of this resourceful spot. These artists speak very highly of the courtesy and kindness shown by Mr. Damon.

Mr. Blaschki is undoubtedly at his best in a glimpse of the bubbling brook to the right of the road. He has treated his subject in a scheme of beautiful low toned greens, and the effect he has obtained makes one feel very happy, without any apparent reason, which is a compliment to both picture and painter. Again in another view of the creek, he has caught in his square oil a charming bit of nature.

Mr. McComas is the water color man of the pair. He has various bits of nature treated in a way new to this part of the world. He shows one magnificent water color, Manoa Valley, painted to order of E. A. Mott-Smith. It is strong and full of color and hangs together well. An evening oil by this same artist is noteworthy for its feeling of quiet and suggestion of the time of day which poets love to sing of.
