#### THE SEE OF HONOLULU.

Acceptance of the Resignation of  
the Bishop of Honolulu by the  
Archbishop of Canterbury.

To all Christian people whom it  
may concern. Greeting.

I hereby certify that a letter of  
resignation of the Bishopric of Ho-  
nolulu, under the hand of the Right  
Reverend Alfred Willis, D.D., Bish-  
op of the Church of England in the  
Hawaiian or Sandwich Islands and  
all other the dominions of His Maj-  
esty the King of Hawaii, styled  
Bishop of Honolulu, dated the sev-  
enteenth day of December, one  
thousand nine hundred and one,  
such resignation to take effect on  
the first day of April, one thousand  
nine hundred and two, was this day  
duly deposited and registered in the  
Principal Registry of the Province  
of Canterbury.

And that the Rt. Honorable and  
Most Reverend Frederick, Lord  
Archbishop of Canterbury, Primate  
of all England, and Metropolitan,  
did on the thirty-first day of Janu-  
ary, one thousand nine hundred and  
two, sign his acceptance of the  
same, and that the said letter of  
resignation and the said acceptance  
are duly registered in this office  
of His Grace's Vicar General.

Dated the twentieth day of Feb-  
ruary, in the year of our Lord one  
thousand nine hundred and two.

WHEREAS, Under or by virtue of  
the Act 5 Victoria, Chapter 6, her  
late Majesty Queen Victoria, by  
Warrant under Her Royal Signet  
and Sign Manual, dated the 27th  
of November, one thousand  
eight hundred and seventy-one, au-  
thorized and empowered the Arch-  
bishop of Canterbury to consecrate  
the Reverend Alfred Willis, M. A.,  
to be Bishop of the Church of Eng-  
land in the Hawaiian or Sandwich  
Islands and all other Dominions  
of His Majesty the King of Haw-  
aiki; and he was duly consecrated  
and has been styled Bishop of Ho-  
nolulu.

AND WHEREAS, The said Islands  
have now been incorporated as ter-  
ritory of the United States of  
America, whereby the branch of the  
Anglican Communion established in  
the United States of America ex-  
tends to all members of that branch  
residing in the Hawaiian Islands.

AND WHEREAS, The said Right  
Reverend Alfred Willis has signified  
to Us in writing, dated seven-  
teenth December, one thousand nine  
hundred and one, that in pursuance  
of an arrangement entered into at  
the recent General Convention of  
the Protestant Episcopal Church in  
the United States of America, held  
at San Francisco, he had under-  
taken to resign his See of Honolulu  
after the Diocesan Synod of the  
Anglican Church in Hawaii had  
given effect to a Resolution adopted  
by the Synod in 1899, and on a  
promise by the Bishops to conse-  
crate, as soon as practicable, a Bish-  
op for the said Hawaiian Islands,  
which are to become, on the first  
April, one thousand nine hundred  
and two, a Missionary District of  
the Protestant Episcopal Church of  
America, and thereby tendered Us  
his resignation of the See of Ho-  
nolulu, to which he was so as afore-  
said consecrated in 1872, such resig-  
nation to take effect on the first  
day of April, one thousand nine  
hundred and two.

Now, WE, FREDERICK, by Divine  
Providence Archbishop of Canter-  
bury, do hereby accept the resig-  
nation of the See of Honolulu, ten-  
dered to Us as aforesaid by said
