

KALAKAUA'S MONUMENT.

Sculptor Schmid Going to Hawaii to Submit His Model.

Rupert Schmid, the local sculptor, will leave this city on Wednesday next for a trip to the Hawaiian Islands. He is to consult Queen Liliohokalani and Colonel Macfarlane about the sculpture of a statue of the late King Kalakaua.

Mr. Schmid's model stands about two feet high and is a remarkably fine piece of work. The bearing of Kalakaua is majestic and noble.

There are two or three marble busts of King Kalakaua extant, but this will be the first full figure.
