VITAL STATISTICS.

Health of Honolulu as Disclosed by the Figures.

The following are the vital statistics for the month ending November 30, as reported by the Board of Health: Deaths in Honolulu for November were 89. Of these 21, or nearly one-fourth, were of children under five years of age.

Health of Honolulu as Disclosed by the Figures.

The city physician visited 191 patients, treated 1,265 at office, sent 5 to hospital and filled 595 prescriptions. The food commissioner tested 55 samples of milk and 5 of food, made 2 prosecutions and 7 chemical analyses, detecting 2 adulterations.

Health of Honolulu as Disclosed by the Figures.

The garbage department pumped 173 cesspools, removed 578 loads of garbage, sent 114 scowloads to sea and removed 4 dead animals. The meat and fish inspectors examined 2,702 animals, condemned 2 carcasses, destroyed 2 tubercular cattle, detected fluke in 163 livers, examined 192,958 fish and condemned 3,346 of them.

People living in the vicinity of the Orpheum alley are complaining of its condition. They say that the barrels from the saloon and rubbish of every description have been piled in the alley until it is next to impossible to pass in or out. And they do not say pleasant things about the odors.
