IN HEART OF VALLEY

Odd Feast of Our Lady of the Mountain.

IN CHAPEL AT KALIHI-WAENA

Portuguese Celebrate Religious Fete Amid Salvoes of Artillery and Fluttering Flags.

Gay fluttering flags of blue and white, emblazoned with the royal arms of Portugal, flaunted in the breezes which swept yesterday down through Kalihi valley, over and about the little Catholic church of Kalihi-waena, where hundreds of Portuguese rendered homage to Our Lady of the Mountain, a feast of much importance to the dwellers of Madeira. No more fitting place than the little chapel of Kalihi-waena with its mountain setting, could have been chosen for the celebration of a feast, associated with the highlands back of a city on Madeira, where most of our Portuguese came from.

Nearly five miles from the Kamehameha schools, away up in the heart of the valley, the little chapel stands surrounded by the most luxuriant growths of tropical verdure. Just there the valley narrows until, with the exception of a brief level space with a stream of water splurging between banks covered with masses of dense shrubbery, ferns and bananas, there is little more than room for the church and road. Everywhere wild nature has asserted herself and with the rains and mists which seem to be constantly tumbling over the fall, the valley is a beautiful place to behold, and one in which the thrifty Portuguese have been quick to perceive advantages for diversified agriculture. From the Kamehameha schools to the uttermost end, the valley is dotted with pretty little cottages surrounded with grape arbors, bananas, pineapples and taro fields, and both sides of the well-made road are lined with the greenest and densest of shrubbery, making the trip up and down one of unequalled attraction in the vicinity of Honolulu.

Gay crowds of Portuguese of all ages and sexes started early for the church yesterday morning, using all manner of conveyances, from light buggies to heavy lumbering 'busses, express wagons and brakes. Scores of people journeyed on foot, it being a pleasant and invigorating walk with the exception of the last mile when occasional showers were met which transformed the road into a morass of red mud.

A turn of the road leading to the chapel brought the visitors into full view of a spectacle which warmed the cockles of the Portuguese heart. Archways of malle and greens spanned the road every ten feet and above each post fluttered a flag of Portugal. Long strings of flags, those of Portugal predominating, criss-crossed the premises immediately surrounding the church. The pathway from the road to the church entrance was flag-flanked, and everywhere the gaze met a bewildering and kaleidoscopic mass of blue and white bunting, with the yellow design of the arms of Portugal appearing through it all. Near the church portal was a stand erected for the accommodation of the Mission Band in which the white-uniformed players, led by bandmaster Rima, played their best.

High upon an eminence two flags floated from tall staffs. Between them was a small tent and the black muzzles of five or six cannon peeped out in a warlike manner from the dense covering of long grasses, and from these, salvoes and volleys were fired every half hour during the day. The discharge of the guns, echoing down the valley toward the sea, the merry laughter of the crowds below, and the ritual of the feast being celebrated with solemnity within the chapel, formed a series of scenes which were of intense interest to the people.

The feast of "Our Lady of the Mountain" commemorates a celebration similar to that of the French in the adoration of Our Lady of Lourdes. It commemorates a time when an apparition of a woman appeared in the mountains, and the Portuguese have ever since attributed this to a visitation of the virgin. In Madeira the feast is one of the most important celebrated during the year. Upon the little altar of the chapel of Kalihi-waena, enveloped in a wreath of flowers, was an image called "Our Lady of the Mountain," and this was worshipped by hundreds of people. A large figure of Our Lady was ordered from Portugal many months ago and should have been here for yesterday's festival, but it was shirked at some point en route, and there was much disappointment among the worshippers.

Father Clement, the chaplain of Kalihi-waena chapel, assisted by Fathers Sylvester and Stephen, were present during the services until the middle of the afternoon when they left for Honolulu, leaving the scores of people to amuse themselves and prepare for the home-journey. Wreaths of the mountain greens were made and placed around hats and when the various vehicles swung into town late in the day they were lined with a lei-bedecked crowd.

The wants of the laborer were satisfied by the contents of large picnic baskets, while the clergy and officials sat down to well laden tables beneath a tent where pig cooked in an imu, potatoes and other palatable things were served. Not only a religious feast at the little chapel of interest to its worshippers, but the ride up and down the valley cannot fail to be full of interest to any who enjoy wild scenes of nature tempered here and there by the cultivator.
