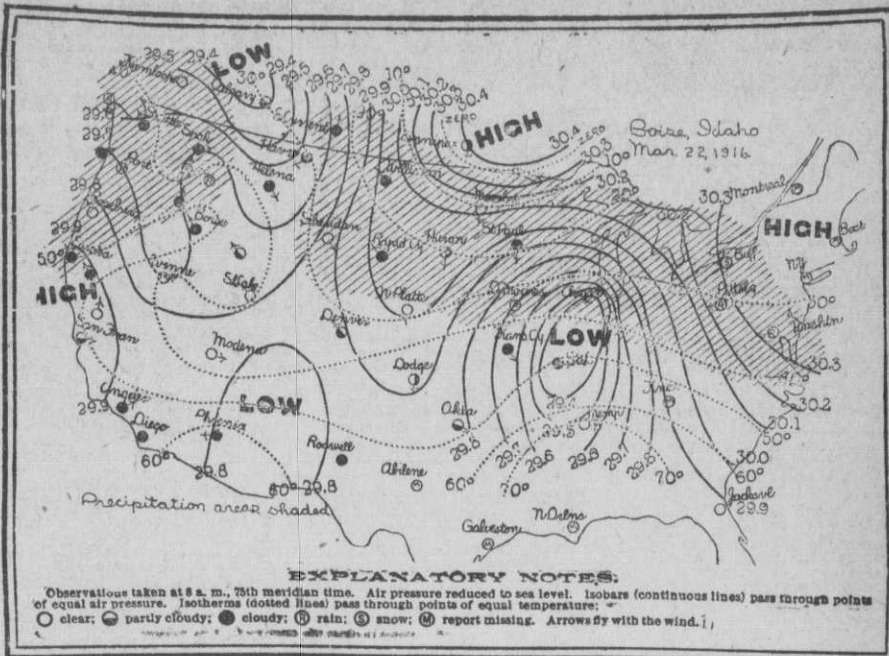

U. S. Department of Agriculture—WEATHER BUREAU

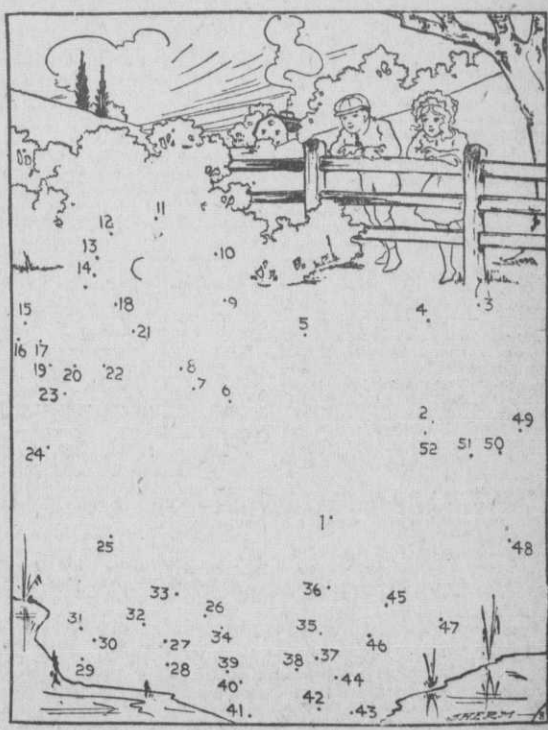


FORECAST FOR BOISE AND VICINITY—Unsettled weather tonight and Thursday, probably with rain.
DAILY REPORT—Highest temperature yesterday, 53; lowest temperature this morning, 48; mean temperature yesterday, 42.
 CONDITIONS—Two important low pressure areas are apparent today, one central in Illinois and overlying the central valleys and the other central in Alberta and covering most of the Pacific and Rocky Mountain states. High pressure extends from the Dakotas and Manitoba eastward and along the Atlantic coast. Precipitation has occurred in most of the northern states. The following heavy rainfall is reported: Tatoosh Island, Wash., 1.08; Portland, Ore., 1.02. The temperature has risen rapidly in parts of Oregon, California and Idaho while in the plains region the weather is much colder. Temperature below zero is reported from Winnipeg, Man. Conditions are unsettled and threaten rain in Boise and its vicinity within the next 36 hours.
