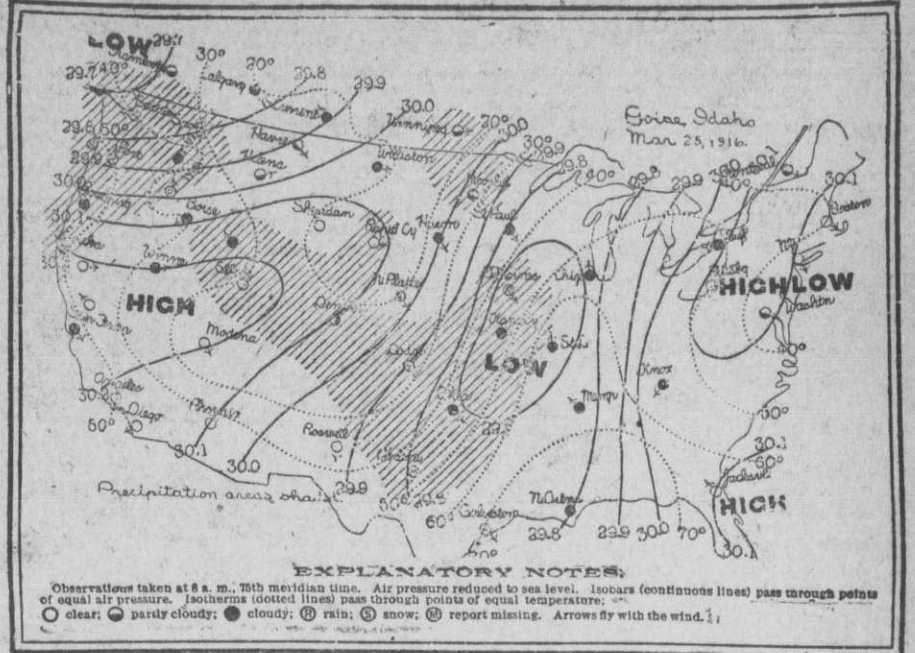

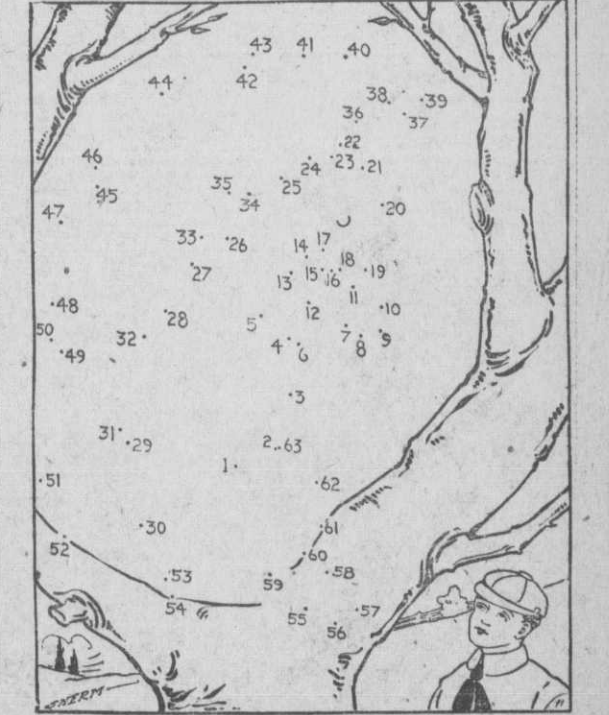


FORECAST FOR BOISE AND VICINITY—Unsettled weather tonight and Sunday, probably with rain or snow. DAILY REPORT—Highest temperature yesterday, 46; lowest temperature yesterday, 36. CONDITIONS—The principal atmospheric depression now extends from Texas and Louisiana to the upper lake region and a less important depression exists over the extreme northwest. High pressure prevails in the east and over a belt reaching from the south Pacific coast to Manitoba. Precipitation has occurred over large areas in the west. The following large amounts are reported: Kansas City, Mo., 1.16; Portland, Ore., 1.15. The weather is warmer on the north Pacific slope and from the upper Mississippi river eastward while in the middle west there has been a decided fall. Unsettled weather is indicated for Boise and its vicinity, with rain or snow within the next 36 hours.
