IT RINGS IN BERLIN



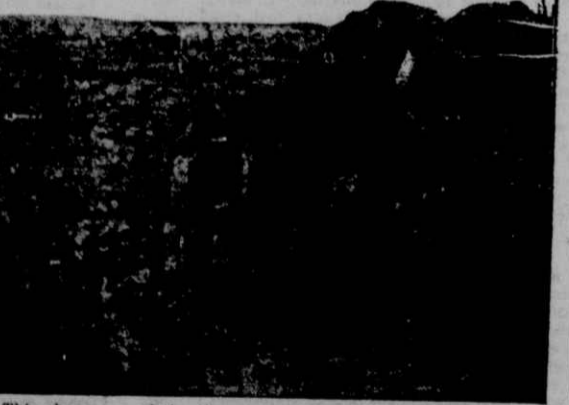
