ELECTION PRECINCTS.
 Registrars, Judges and Clerks of
 Election.

The matter of fixing the boundaries of, and
 creating new voting precincts, coming up to
 be heard after consideration, it is ordered by
 the Board that the voting precincts of Bing-
 ham county are and shall be bounded and de-
 scribed as follows, to-wit: and it is further or-
 dered that the persons named after the pre-
 cincts described are and shall be the Regis-
 trars, Judges of Election and Distributing
 Clerks, respectively, of the various precincts:

AMMON.
 Commencing at the southwest corner of sec-
 tion 2, township 1 north, range 38 east; thence
 north 5 miles to the northwest corner section
 21, township 2 north, range 38 east; thence
 east 4 miles to the southeast corner of sec-
 tion 13, township 2 north, range 38 east; thence
 east along the section line to the range line be-
 tween ranges 42 and 44 east; thence south 4
 miles to the southeast corner of section 13,
 township 1 north, range 42 east; thence west
 along the section line to the place of begin-
 ning.

BASALT.
 Commencing at a point on the east bank of
 Snake river where the same crosses the base
 line, thence east to the range line between
 ranges 38 and 39 east, thence south along the
 range line to where said line crosses the Black-
 foot river, thence down said river with the
 meanders thereof to a point where said
 river crosses the range line between ranges
 36 and 37 east, thence north along the
 range line to the southwest corner
 of section 26, township 2 south, range 37
 east, thence west along said section line to
 east bank of Snake river with the meanders
 thereof to the place of beginning.

BLACKFOOT.

 of section 13, township 2 south, range 36 east,
 thence west along the section line to the east
 bank of Snake river, thence down the east
 bank of Snake river, thence across the meanders
 thereof to the place of beginning.

DANILSON SPRINGS.
 Commencing at the southwest corner of
 township 6 south, range 39 east, thence east
 along the township line to and across to the
 east bank of Snake river, thence up the east
 bank of Snake river, thence north along the
 township line to the meanders thereof to
 the north line of township 4 south,
 range 31 east, thence west along the town-
 ship line to the Lincoln county line, thence
 south along said line to place of beginning.

FAIRVIEW.
 Commencing at the northeast corner of
 township 3 north, range 38 east, thence west
 along the township line to the east bank of
 Snake river, thence down the east bank of
 Snake river to the township line between
 township 2 and 3 north, thence east along the
 township line to the southeast corner of sec-
 tion 33, township 3 north, range 38 east, thence
 north along the section line to where said
 line crosses Willow creek, thence up said
 creek with the meanders thereof to a point
 where the same crosses the range line be-
 tween ranges 38 and 39 east, thence north
 along the range line to the place of beginning.

GRAYS.
 Commencing at the southwest corner of
 township 4 south, range 39 east, on the south
 line of Bingham county, thence east along
 said line to the east line of Bingham county,
 thence north along said line to the base line,
 thence west along the base line to the north-
