

# COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

Blackfoot, Idaho, Monday, April 10, 1911.

County of Bingham, ss.

The Board of County Commissioners met on this day in regular session pursuant to law, present W. H. Stufflebeam, chairman, T. R. Jones and T. J. Bennett, commissioners, J. T. Carruth, clerk when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

In the matter of the refund of tax of Nellie M. Wall.

This matter coming on regularly to be heard at this time and it appearing to the Board that certain delinquent taxes on lots one and two and seven and the North half of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast, Northeast quarter of southeast quarter of section twenty-two, Township three south of range thirty-four, for the year 1901 had been erroneously assessed. It was ordered that the delinquent taxes for the said year 1901 be and the same are hereby cancelled and that a check for One Hundred four and forty-two hundredths dollars from the said Nellie M. Wall be accepted as full payment for delinquent taxes for the years 1899 and 1900.

In the matter of approving reports of County Officers.

The following officers have filed their reports for the county and on March 31st, the same were fully considered and approved and filed, Frank W. Jordan, J. T. Carruth, H. C. Bucklin, Frank E. DeKay, J. H. Anderson. In the matter of the appointment of F. D. Bennett, deputy assessor. F. D. Bennett having been appointed Deputy Assessor and Collector and

his appointment and official oath having been regularly filed the said appointment was approved.

In the matter of allowance to the indigents.

The matter coming on for hearing at this time and it appearing to the Board that certain parties as herein-after named are in need of assistance from the County it is therefore ordered that said parties be, and they are, hereby allowed the amounts as follows: Hannah Holgate, \$30.00 per month, Nellie M. Boise, \$30.00 per month.

In the matter of the application of A. V. Scott for refund of taxes.

A. V. Scott, having presented to the Board on this day a petition setting forth that the lots numbered one to six, twenty-five to thirty-four, three to forty-eight in Block fifty-three, Crow's Addition to Idaho Falls, Idaho assessed for the same year twice, and said taxes having been paid it is therefore ordered that the said taxes amounting to \$39.00 be refunded to the said A. V. Scott.

In the matter of the cancellation of the bonds of F. W. Jordan and H. C. Bucklin.

William L. McConnell, Esq. of Idaho Falls having come before the board on this day, agent of the Title Guaranty and Surety Company, requested that the said Title Guaranty and Surety Company be released from their liability on the bonds of the above named parties, it is ordered that the said liability be released from and after February 16th, 1911 and Chairman sign certificate to this effect.
