MINE HORSE WEARS SNOWSHOES

John Morrison, a Wallace liveryman and freighter, is the owner of a horse called Dan, which does a trick in his everyday life the equal to the "stunts" attempted by the trained animals in the dog and pony shows. This horse walks on snow shoes. He does it not to amuse, but to aid his master in packing.

It is impossible to get into some of the country's prospects with an ordinary horse and sled. Dan, however, is accomplishing the trick now, and will throughout the dead of winter. Given his snow shoes he will get there though the surface is covered 20 feet deep.

The shoes the horse wears are round, and similar in construction to those worn by men. They are fastened to the horse's feet with leather thongs. Once they are properly attached Dan walks along with as much ease as a city horse would travel on a paved street.

Sam McDonald was the first to make use of Dan's accomplishments this year. In the Sunset district in which his property is located, the snow has piled deep. When he found it necessary to take supplies through the other day he took Dan and the snowshoes and expects to make the trip without trouble.
