ORE BOAT ON SO. CHICAGO SANDBAR

CHICAGO, Nov. 24.—Grave fears were expressed today for the safety of the ore boat Memphis, of the Pittsburgh Steamship Co., which is aground on a sandbar two and one-half miles off South Chicago. The captain and thirty-six members of the crew are on board and a detachment from the

Jackson Park coast station is standing by to take them off should it become necessary to abandon the ship.

The Memphis, a 600 foot vessel, has been plying between the northern Michigan ore ports and South Chicago. The force of her impact with the sandbar was so great that several plates in her side were sprung and her machinery paralyzed by water that poured through the openings.

PRICES HIGHER THAN IN 1919

CHICAGO, Nov. 24.—Despite recent

drops in prices of some foodstuffs, a Thanksgiving dinner here will cost approximately \$1 more than it did in 1919, according to estimates supplied by leading grocers. Turkeys are higher this year, the average price being 67 cents per pound, as against 50 cents per pound a year ago.
