

### BOOST PRICE OF STAMPED ENVELOPES

#### Postmaster Hunter Notified of Increase By Washington Office

Postmaster Hunter was advised Tuesday that owing to the increased cost of manufacture the prices of stamped envelopes have been slightly increased, effective after Sept. 1. The number five, white or amber, two-cent, have raised 20 cents on the thousand; number seven's, 32 cents; number eight's, 36 cents; number nine's, 38 cents; and number 12's, 24 cents.

A permit is not necessary for the importation of the following merchandise into Germany: Foodstuffs for the personal use of the importer, when the following restrictions are complied with, each parcel should contain only one kilogram (two pounds) of each of the following articles: margarine, fat, bread and all baker goods, pastes, macaroni, tea and coffee.

Soap, candies and starch are not to exceed five pounds; no package should contain butter, sugar, flour, pickles or lobster. Foodstuffs and personal effects sent as gifts and for the personal use of the addressee will be admitted by German customs officers free of duty, who, however, must be satisfied that the foodstuffs and effects are really and destined solely for the personal use of the addressee and members of his family.

### TITLED AUSTRIANS HOLD THEIR HONORS

VIENNA, Sept. 7.—Former bearers of Austrian titles, now prohibited, are trying to perpetuate them locally by changing their names, so that the title hyphenated to the family name, becomes a legal name. For instance the Count von Grabentien would become Graf-Grabentien. But the government has ruled in principle that this cannot be done.

Some of the old aristocracy still evade the law by using visiting cards, obviously newly printed, with the title and the von lightly lined through with pen or pencil. One young Vienna noble, with a sense of humor, has a card about like this:

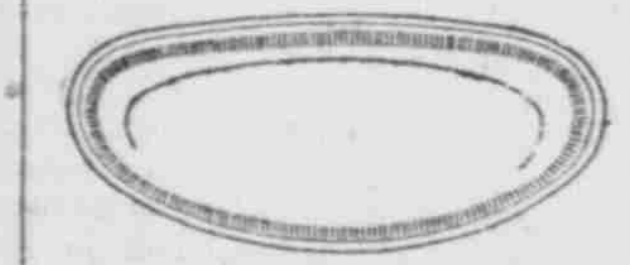

### MODERN DRESS HIT BY WELSH PASTOR

CARDIFF, Wales, Sept. 7.—Again a British clergyman has put his foot down against the prevailing fashions in women's dress and refused to give communion to all women who kneel at the altar rail in attire which he may regard as immodest. Father Joseph Parlin, celebrating high mass at Saint Paul's Roman Catholic church here, issued the following warning to his congregation: "I hope," he said, "that lady members of my parish will not attempt to attire themselves in some of the present day fashions. If any immodestly dressed woman approaches the altar for Holy Communion I shall refuse to allow her to partake of the sacrament, passing her by as if she did not exist."

### Catholic Priest Deaf And Dumb From Birth

BORDEAUX, France, Sept. 7.—Jean Marie Joseph Charles La Fonta, novice of the Order of the Assumption, who has just been ordained priest, is according to church authorities, the first person deaf and dumb from birth received into the Roman Catholic priesthood in history. During two years of study at Rome the Abbe La Fonta was given special examinations and finally the way into the church was opened for him by order of the Pope.

### ARGENTINA BUILDS EMBASSIES ABROAD

BUENOS AIRES, Sept. 7.—Argentina plans to raise to the rank of embassies her legations in England, France, Italy and Germany, placing them on the same footing as her foreign representations in Spain and in the United States. This higher standing of the Argentin

representations in Paris and London will be accompanied with their rank. Appropriations for these purchases have already been asked for and are included in the budget for 1920. An appropriation for the embassy at Madrid will be asked for later on. In this manner all Argentine embassies in America and Europe will be installed in edifices of their own.
