McCray's Neighbors Deny He Is "Dirt" Farmer Except in Capacity Dodging His Taxes

Never "Followed Plow" in Life Save as Board of Trade Gambler.

Special to The News-Times: KENTLAND, Ind., Oct. 5.—An anonymous note is struck in the Indiana gubernatorial campaign, that resounded loud here in the home town of Warren T. McCray...

McCray is not a farmer, nor has he lived on a farm since his early youth. He is a banker, a grain dealer and a stock broker.

According to his friends in Kentland he "never followed a plow in his life" and they express great surprise that there is a prevalent notion in Indiana that he is a "farmer candidate."

"You had better refer to him as the "board of trade candidate," these people say, "for that is his real profession."

Mr. McCray has lived in Kentland since early in his youth and before he was 19 years old conducted a grocery store there.

Following the death of his father he took the presidency of the Discount and Deposit bank of Kentland and has maintained offices in the bank building for years.

At one time he controlled several elevators in this county, although it is said he has disposed of his grain interests within the last year or so, with the exception of his connection with the board of trade.

Mr. McCray owns 881 acres of land and has an expert farm manager in charge of the farm and the pedigree cattle raised there.

The assessment sheet in the county auditor's office shows that Mr. McCray's residential connections with the farm are very remote.

Among the interesting articles listed on his personal sheet in Kentland, Mr. McCray gave in a billiard table valued at \$70.

He gave in for assessment two and one-half automobiles valued at \$900. A notation in handwriting in connection with the automobiles reads: "3/4 of Buick to sister."

In this connection it is interesting to note that while the total assessment of personal property on his farm is given as \$120,325 the amount of insurance carried there is \$150,000.

30 DAYS AND FINE FOR SHELLENBACK

Judge Imposes Penalty on Man Found Guilty of Liquor Sales.

He is so strongly opposed to incarceration that when his appeal from the city court, where he was convicted of selling intoxicating liquors three months ago, was decided in superior court Tuesday morning, Shellenback pleaded ill health and offered Judge Montgomery to pay even a heavier fine than the court appeared disposed to give him if he were allowed his personal freedom.

Schellenback was arrested by federal men here three months ago when they made numerous raids in the city. Schellenback was tried in city court and was fined \$100 and sentenced to 60 days in jail by Judge Glimmer.
