Three House members are elected from each legislative district.

Each voter has three votes for Representatives in the General Assembly. All three votes may be cast for one, one and one-half each for two, or one each for three candidates.

Ballot marked like this for Representatives counts one vote for Smith, one vote for Brown, and one vote for Jones.
