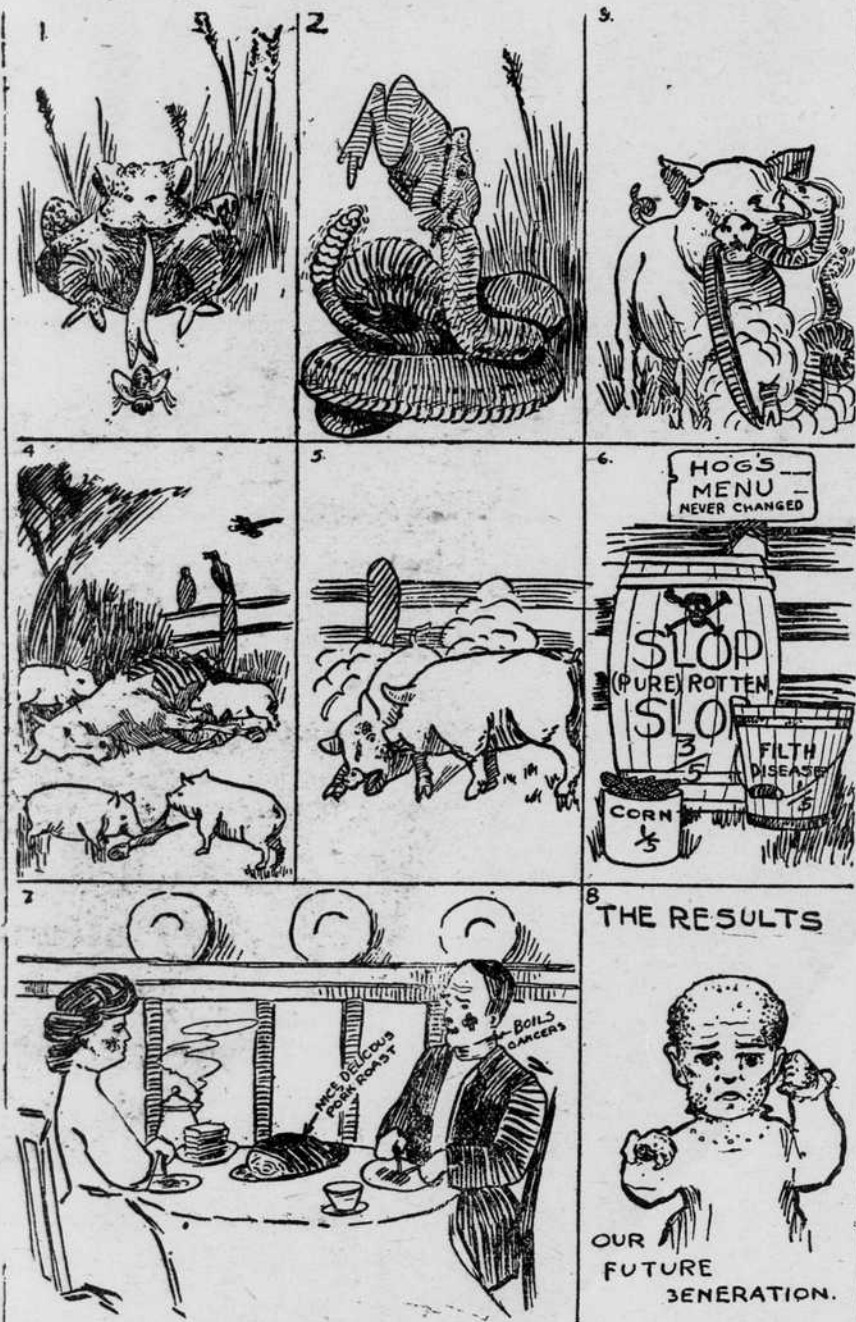
It is a scrofulous, cancerous, tuberculosis and cholera, and trichinosis breeding flesh.

Doctors and Drugs, Surgeons and Knives

I.—The Origin of Medicine Is Found in Heathenism.

The practice of medicine originated in heathenism, in the worship of demons. It can be readily traced back through its history to the heathen gods. Apollo was the presiding deity of medicine. Apollo was also called Phoebus, another name for the sun, thus showing that medicine is a part of sun-worship.

Ponder the meaning of the following Greek words used in the New Testament:

(1) Pharmakeia. (a) The use or the administering of drugs. (b) Poisoning. (c) Sorcery; Magical Arts. See Galatians 5:20; Revelation 18:23.

(2) Pharmakeus (Pharmakon) One who prepares or uses Magical remedies; A Sorcerer. Revelation 21:8

(3) Pharmakon, a drug; an enchantment. Revelation 9:21.

(4) Pharmakos, Pertaining to Magical Arts.

A Pharmacist is, therefore, a Sorcerer according to God's Word. Read Exodus 15:26. "I am the Lord that healeth thee."

Jeremiah 17:5 "Cursed is the man that trusteth in man, and maketh flesh his arm, and whose heart departeth from the Lord."

Jeremiah 46:11: "In vain dost thou use many medicines."

Job 13:4: "Ye are all physicians of no value."

Ezekiel 34:4: "The diseased have ye not strengthened, neither have ye healed that which was sick."

2 Chronicles 16:12, 13: "And . . . Asa was diseased in his feet: his disease was exceeding great: yet in his disease he sought not to the Lord, but to the physicians. And Asa slept with his fathers."

James 5:14, 15: "Is any among you sick, let him call for the Elders of the Church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the Name of the Lord: and the prayer of faith shall save him that is sick, and the Lord shall raise him up."

Luke 13:16: "And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, to have been loosed from this bond?"

Mark 5:25, 26: "And a woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years, and had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse."

Acts 10:38: "Even Jesus of Nazareth, how that God anointed Him with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with Him."

1 John 3:8 "He that doeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. To this end was the Son of God manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil."

Sir Astley Cooper, physician to Queen Victoria, has declared, "The science of medicine is founded upon conjecture and improved by murder." What a shocking statement from a man so eminent as to have the royal family in his professional care!
