in the way of wooden cups, goblets, rolling pins, and so on.

The course for the past year's work included not only plain, square jointing, but mortise and tennon jointing which is very particular work; also mitre jointing.

Perhaps the best piece of finished work in the room consisted of a stained, golden oak piano bench, designed by a pupil assisted by the teacher. It showed both mitre and blind mortise and tennon jointing. The legs had been turned by the pupil on the lathe, and fluted, by hand, with a plane made for that special purpose. The base and legs had been sawn and chiseled out. The finishing had been done by means of a plane, a cabinet scraper and two grades of sandpaper.

Another excellent piece of work, a piano bench, had been done by a girl graduate of the Preparatory Department. It contained twenty-six mortise and tennon joints. The top consisted of two pieces of wood; but one would never have noticed the joint if his attention had not been called to it, so neatly was it fitted together. The piece had been planed and sandpapered, and only lacked filling, staining and varnishing to be complete.

Another girl graduate had constructed a bookrack, the joints of which were not glued, but held together by means of eight pins. The shelves were all grooved into place, and the piece was very neatly and substantially made. It was all complete, except waxing.

A neat piece of work was a library table, each leg consisting of four pieces. The top had the appearance of being a thick plank, but, in reality, was only a 7-8 inch board, with an additional strip underneath. The two were so nicely glued and fitted together that one could not distinguish the difference except by close inspection. The stain had been mixed and applied by the pupil.

A lamp stand, by a First Year boy, supported a lighted electric lamp. There were also other pieces of work by First Year pupils, including a number of bird houses.

In order to teach the plans, methods and processes of building, a miniature residence was under construction by the Fourth Year Preparatory boys.

The doors and window openings had all been framed in. The first floor consisted of a living room, dining room, kitchen, bedroom and pantry, with connective hallways. The second story had not been partitioned off.

While speaking of the Manual Training Department, we must not omit the fact that the many pictures hanging on the walls of the various rooms in the College Building were framed by the pupils taking this course. The beautiful Ship of Zion, seen in the Junior Closing Exercises also was constructed in this department.
