In pursuance of a resolution adopted by the City Council of the City of Zion at its regular meeting on January 27, 1919, the Committee on Fire & Water announces that it is open for the receipt of competitive bids on the installation of a concrete reservoir for the storage of water for fire protection in the downtown district.

### SPECIFICATIONS

Reservoir to be placed in South East corner of enclosed space South of Administration Building. To have an approximate capacity of one thousand one hundred fifty (1,150) barrels.  
Dimensions to be 20x20x12 feet deep.  
Walls and floor to be of concrete re-enforced with heavy wire. Walls to be 12 inches thick, floor 4 inches thick. To have cement posts five feet apart to carry plank roof, same to be provided with covered man-hole for entry of fire hose.  
Man-hole to be in North East corner.  
All materials and workmanship to be of standard grade and reservoir to be reasonably water-tight throughout.
