THE NEWS IN BRIEF.
The papers for the Minnesota State were arranged Monday, and approximately \$10,000 and \$20,000.

Gen. Franz Sigel has been appointed to a position in the office of the county clerk of New York, where he will enjoy a salary of \$3,500 a year.

Gen. Logan has bought the commodious, old-fashioned mansion on Clifton Heights, the highest promontory overlooking Washington on its northern bluff.

Extension of the Northwestern.
Chicago, July 29.—A corps of Chicago & Northwestern railroad engineers have completed a preliminary survey for a line of that road from Cambridge to Yankton, and report that they have found a good route.

He Was Determined to Drown.
Chapel Hill, N. C., July 29.—The body of S. Hexter, an old man and successful merchant, was found in the lake near the breakwater Monday. It seems that last Wednesday he loaded himself down with iron and deliberately jumped off the pier. He was troubled with insomnia, which caused great mental depression.

The Alabama Claims Court.
Washington City, July 29.—The court of commissioners of Alabama claims will adjourn Wednesday until Oct. 5. The court has ordered that on resuming all the claims cases shall be taken up in the order of their docket numbers, and be finally tried or disposed of as far as the remaining time of the court will permit.

What's the Matter with Bartlett.
Boston, July 29.—Dr. Martin Bartlett has resigned the position of medical pension examiner. He declined to serve with Dr. George F. Bartlett, and is the third appointee of the present commission who has resigned for the same reason. Dr. Bartlett was appointed recently by Commissioner Wood.

The Cholera in Spain.
Washington City, July 29.—United States Consul Schenck at Barcelona reports that in the cholera infected districts of Spain there were 23,944 cases and 12,247 deaths during the months of March, April, and May.
