**Attempt to Extradite Chas. A. Siringo, Former Detective, Who Exposed Pinkerton Agency in His Book, Is Stopped—Chicago Sleuth Returns Alone.**

**THE BIG DOINGS**

Here is the dope for the Prosperity Day parade today:

11 a. m.—Paraders start mobilizing in Grant Park.

1:30 p. m.—Mayor-elect Thompson and party make round of Grant park in automobiles.

Municipal salute of aerial bombs and daylight fireworks in Grant park.

2 p. m.—Parade starts from Grant park.

8 p. m.—Inauguration ceremonies in council chamber, city hall.

Night fireworks in Grant park.

8:30-9 p. m.—Inaugural and "prosperity" balls in downtown hotels.

Line of March—West from Grant park in Monroe st., north in State, west in Randolph, south in La Salle, east in Jackson, south in Michigan.
