

## BAKES BREAD FOR UNCLE SAM

Miss Hannah L. Wessling is Uncle Sam's professional baker. Her mission is mere bread-making, but not in an ordinary kitchen. Her work is done in government laboratories.

The loaves she makes are used as tests to set new standards for the American housewife and the professional baker.

Miss Wessling's careful experiments are expected to solve many problems of the woman who makes her own bread. For instance, her tests will probably determine the best-sized loaf to bake and the right temperature of the oven. They are expected to settle the problem of proper selections of flour and quantities of flour; also proportions of liquid, salt, sugar, etc., to be used.
