GIRL BROOM WORKERS STRIKE

The staff of girl employes of the United States Broom and Brush Co. factory, Clybourn av. and Cortland st., walked out on strike today because four of their sister employes were discharged after attending a meeting of the International Broom Workers' Union last night.

At this meeting the U. S. Broom

and Brush Co. was strongly lashed because of the conditions at the factory which the girls condemned.

Miss Agnes Nestor, president of the Women's Trade Union League, was one of the speakers who touched on that point. When four of the girls, known to have been at the meeting, came for work this morning they were summarily discharged.
