

GOLDEN SUFFRAGE CAR WITH CRUSADERS AND GOWNS STARTS 15,000-MILE TOUR

New York, April 12—Look out for the "Golden War Car" of the Woman Suffrage party!

Driven by Mrs. Alice S. Burke and Miss Nell Richardson of the National American Woman Suffrage association, the little automobile has started on the first lap of a 15,000-mile tour which will carry the two suffrage crusaders twice across the continent.

Christened with a bottle of gasoline by Mrs. Carrie Chapman Catt, national president of the suffragists,

the tiny machine left New York amid a shower of yellow daffodils.

"We expect to make from 75 to 100 miles a day," said Mrs. Burke. "And will arrive in Chicago and St. Louis in time to attend the suffrage demonstrations there during the big party conventions on June 7 and 14.

"Our first stop will be at Trenton, N. J. After that the route lies through Maryland, Virginia, Texas, Arizona, California, Washington, Montana, Illinois and Ohio."

The little fellow car is fitted out
