

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE CITY COUNCIL.

Council Chamber, Cairo, Illinois, December 8, 1908.

(Second Regular Meeting.)

Present: Aldermen Burke, Cannon, Davis, Ferguson, Gorman, Magner, Meehan, Nellis, Scullin and Thistlewood.

Absent: Hon. George Parsons, mayor, and Aldermen Bourgeois, Greaney, Kelly and Koehler.

In the absence of the mayor the meeting was called to order by the city clerk.

Alderman Scullin moved that Alderman Meehan be chosen as mayor pro tem. The motion was adopted unanimously.

Alderman Meehan thereupon took the chair.

Alderman Thistlewood moved the minutes of last meeting be approved without reading. The motion was adopted unanimously.

Reports of Committees.

The street committee reported recommending that the bid of Hanes & Son to construct sidewalks under the terms and specifications of Ordinance No. 175 for 15c per square foot; Ordinance No. 171 for 15c per square foot; Ordinance No. 161 for 13c per square foot, and Ordinances 173 and 172 for 15c per square foot each, be accepted and contract awarded thereunder under the terms and conditions of their bid and of the respective ordinances.
