Increased Wages Cause 5,000 Men to Return to Railroads. Washington, Aug. 14.—Higher wages recently granted railroad shopmen have resulted in recalling to railway employment more than 5,000 workers who had left previously to accept jobs with higher pay. This has stimulated railroad work on cars and locomotives and the railroad administration expect to clean up before winter the entire accumulation of thousands of damaged cars on sidings for the last year.
