The number of Texas cattle received at the Union stock yards, Chicago in 1881, to July 15th, was 33,500, for the same period in 1882, 115,780, increase this year over last 77,280. The arrivals during the month of March 1882, were 400 head, month of April 2,200, month of May, 28,500, month of June, 58,280, month of July, up to date, 29,400. Arrivals during the month of May, 1881, 1,000, month of June, 12,500, month of July to the 15th, 25,000. Current receipts and the aggregate receipts this year are very much heavier than last. In ordinary years the Texas season is not fairly inaugurated there until July, and this year receipts were 58,280 during June, against 12,500 during the corresponding month last year.
