RAILROAD NEWS.

Attorney Evans of the Rock Island in Washington.

Reports Favorably on the Resurvey of Indian Lands.

TERRITORY TO OPEN.

Permission Asked For a New Line of Railroad.

New Freight Depot to Be Built at Lawrence.

Press dispatches from Washington, D. C., say that W. F. Evans, assistant attorney for the Rock Island, is conferring with the interior department regarding the opening of the Kiowa-Comanche-Apache reservation.

Several weeks ago Mr. Evans representing the Rock Island road signed a contract with the government by which the Rock Island people were to make the resurvey of the Indian lands about to be opened.

From the progress made he feels warranted in saying that the surveying work will be completed by the last of June, but in any event will be finished before August 6, the time when the reservation is to be opened by proclamation.

While in Washington the department representative will be through with that part of the work as soon as the surveying is done. Mr. Nesler is following the Kiowa reservation. He has a number of assistants, and the findings are given the lands they desire as rapidly as they can be satisfied and indicate their choice.

Freight Depot For Lawrence. Lawrence, March 28.—Santa Fe engineers have begun work on the new freight depot at Lawrence, Kan., which will be completed by the end of the month.

U. P. Gets New Line. New York, March 28.—Confirmation was had yesterday of the report that papers have been signed between the Oregon Short Line company, which is a part of the Union Pacific company and the White Knob company, limited, commencing a contract for about 800 miles of track.

NEW INTERLOCKING PLANT. Safety System For Santa Fe and Rock Island.

ANNUAL WATCH INSPECTION. Work of Inspecting G. C. & S. E. Time-Pieces Completed.
