LEGAL. ORDINANCE NO. 2148.

AN ORDINANCE Authorizing "The Topeka Federal Light, Heat and Power Company" to construct, acquire, operate and maintain gas and electric works for the city of Topeka.

Section 1. There is hereby granted to "The Topeka Federal Light, Heat and Power Company" a corporation duly organized under and subject to the laws of the state of Kansas.

Section 2. Said "The Topeka Federal Light, Heat and Power Company" shall not charge any person desiring to make connections with any service pipe laid or to be laid by the city of Topeka.

Section 3. For the purpose of electrical transmission, as provided in this ordinance, the city of Topeka shall have the right to use any public utility poles.
