CONSTABLES KILLED.

A Score of Them Driven Into the Swamps.

State Militia Refuses to Obey and Disbands.

TILLMAN HAS NERVE.

He Promptly Seizes the Railroad Lines

To Prevent Reinforcements Reaching the Rebels.

COLUMBIA, S. C., March 31.—The state is in an uproar over the riot at Darlington yesterday, resulting from the attempt of Governor Tillman to enforce the law closing illegal saloons. Two of the state's constables were killed and two citizens were wounded. The riot occurred at the depot at 3:30 p. m., as the constables were leaving the town.

Constable Brennan, the officer who left Darlington by the Charleston, Sumter & Newberry road here.
