Attorney General Godard on Sheriff's and Treasurer's Terms. Attorney General Godard announced yesterday that county officers will hold over until the 1902 election...

Without citing authorities, or giving reasons for my views, I will state them to you briefly as follows: County officers now in office will continue to hold their offices without re-election or appointment during the ensuing year...
