THE ELECTION PRECINCTS

OF HOPKINS COUNTY - THEY NUMBER TWENTY.

Every Voter Should Familiarize Himself With the Several Boundaries.

In obedience to the requirements of an act of the General Assembly of Kentucky, entitled "An act to regulate elections in this Commonwealth," approved June 26th, 1892, it is now ordered that the six judicial districts in Hopkins county be divided into election precincts, the place of voting in each, and the names and boundaries thereof to be given below, to-wit:

LIST OF VOTING PRECINCTS IN THE COUNTY OF HOPKINS.

White Plains Precinct No. 1.—Beginning at the south of Drake's creek, thence up said creek to the Christian county line, thence with said county line westerly to the mouth of Pond River, thence down said river to the beginning. Voting place, White Plains.

Kitchen Precinct No. 1, in District No. 2.—Beginning at the center stone in the town of Madisonville, running thence with Main street and the Madisonville and Earlington road to the southeast corner of S. P. Merrill's farm, thence a straight line to the southeast corner of Judge Sisk's farm on the Princeton road, thence with said road to where the turnpike road crosses Clear creek near Lee O'Bryan's, thence with said road to Stanford Adams', including Stanford Adams and Brad Graham, thence a straight line to the House Brown house at the west end of Main Cross street, thence with said street to the beginning. Voting place, west of Main street and south of Main Cross street in Madisonville.
