Lake Charles American Press:  
A beginning of their betterment has already been made. The parish of Jefferson has been made law-abiding and orderly under military rule. The shot I has been obliged to disband his army of 145 deputies. The gambling industry has ceased and such gambling paraphernalia as could be found has been destroyed. The attorney general of the state has been directed to take steps toward the removal from office of the two district judges, and a petition for the removal from office of the accused parish officials will be filed with the proper authorities. If any of these officials have been wrongfully accused, they will have an opportunity to vindicate themselves, but not before a court of their own creation.
