14-DAY DIPPING MEANS PROMPT ERADICATION

THE STATE CAN BE MADE ENTIRELY TICK-FREE IN ONE SEASON.

EVERYONE MUST CO-OPERATE

Louisiana is the Only State Using the Two-Week Dipping Period.

Some of the most important frequently asked questions are answered below by Dr. W. D. Moore, Director of the Department of Veterinary Medicine, Louisiana State University.

Why is it necessary to dip cattle every 14 days during the season to get rid of the ticks? Answer: During the warm season of the year, the average time required by the tick to develop, from the small larval, or first stage, after attaching to cattle, until the large female tick matures and drops to the ground to lay her eggs, is about 22 days...

How has this information been obtained? Answer: It has been observed by those engaged in the work of tick eradication that, towards the end of the season, under the 14-day method, there are always a number of cattle, or herds, still remaining tick-infested. While with 14-day dipping there may be none, or only very few, ticks on them.

Then the dipping periods are based upon the time required for the ticks to develop on the cattle and fall off? Answer: Practically so. The adoption of the 14-day periods is to destroy all of the ticks that have become attached to the cattle in the intervals between dippings, without any of them having dropped off.

How long, relatively, will it take to clean a parish, or section, of ticks under the 14-day and 21-day dipping periods? Answer: With the full co-operation of everyone interested, the ticks may be cleaned up in one season under the 14-day periods; while under the 21-day periods it may take two or three seasons, depending on the care in the number of dippings.

Do ticks have any effect on milk production? Answer: Ticks do not have any effect on the production of milk by the cow, but they do have a very serious effect on the health of the cow, and they are a source of annoyance to the farmer.

What effect do the ticks have, if any, on the development of beef cattle? Answer: They prevent development, because a great deal of the blood which the feed makes, and that should be used to nourish the animal, is appropriated by the ticks, and the benefit of the feed is, therefore, lost to the animal.

Are all the other states dipping their cattle every 14 days? Answer: Yes. Some of them adopted the 14-day periods at the beginning of the war, and others that had commenced with the 21 days have since abandoned the longer intervals for the 14-day method, as the results have been found so much more satisfactory.

It is believed, then, that it is possible to eradicate the cattle ticks from a parish, or even the state, if all the cattle are dipped in the standard arsenical solution every 14 days for one season? Answer: Yes. It is being done in other states, and parts of this state at the present time. However, to be able to accomplish it satisfactorily it will require co-operation on the part of everyone concerned and interested in the work.
