Wanted 24 Hours a Day: News Pictures

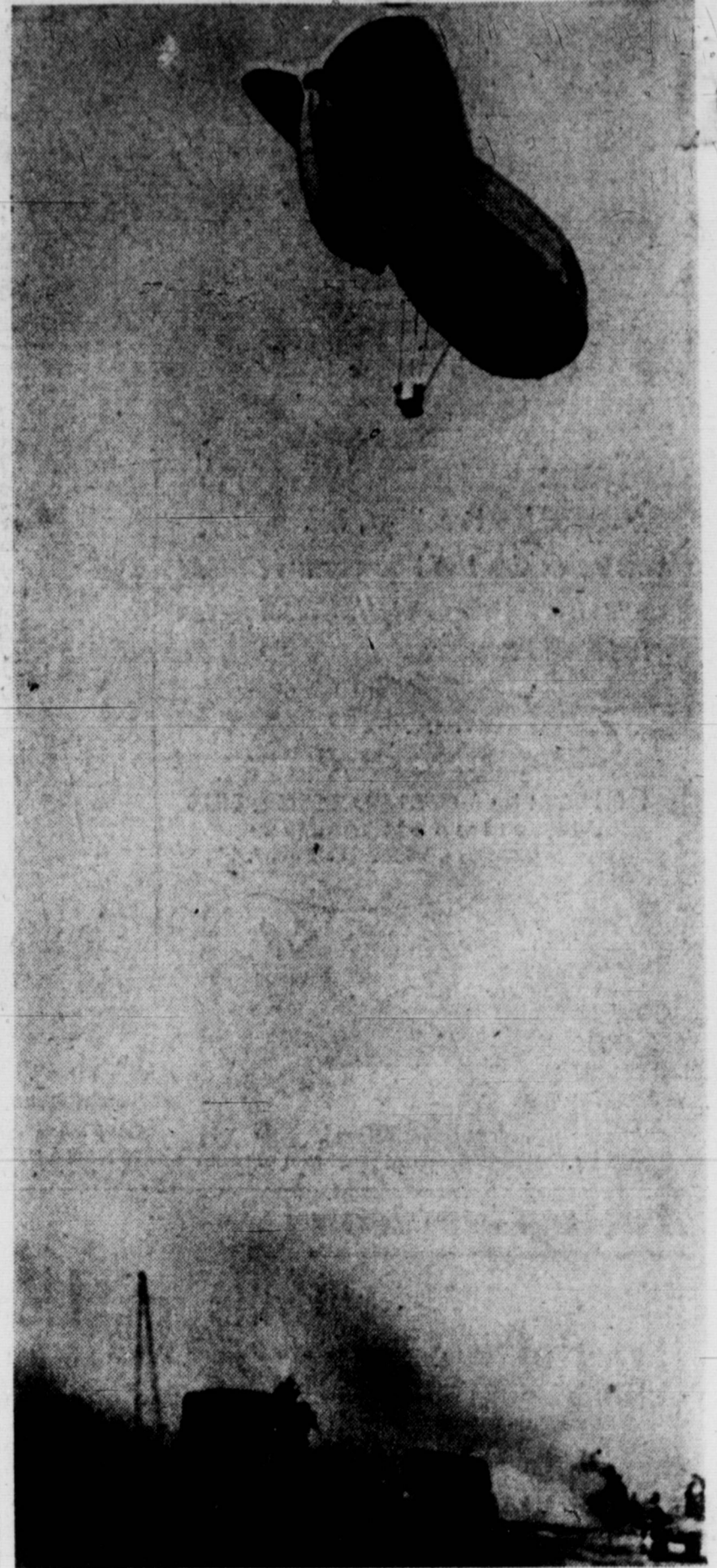
The Detroit Times pays from \$5 to \$25 each for NEWSWORTHY pictures by amateur photographers.

or last Summer's snapshots are not wanted.

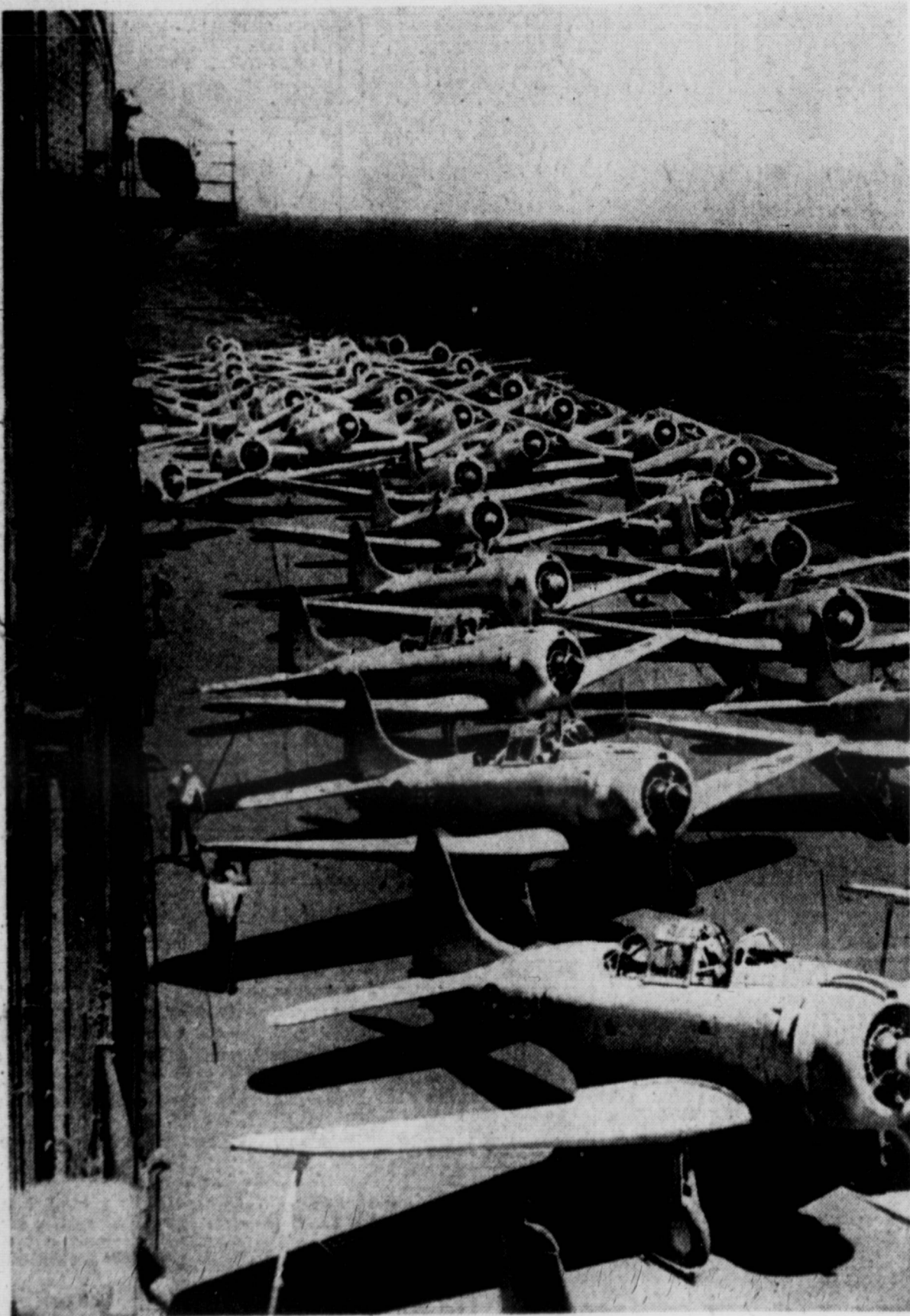
Pictures must be delivered promptly after they are made to the Times Picture Editor, sixth floor of the Times Building. They may be sent developed or undeveloped.

The flight deck of an American aircraft carrier (unnamed) in the Pacific, with the propeller still on only one of these readied airplanes.

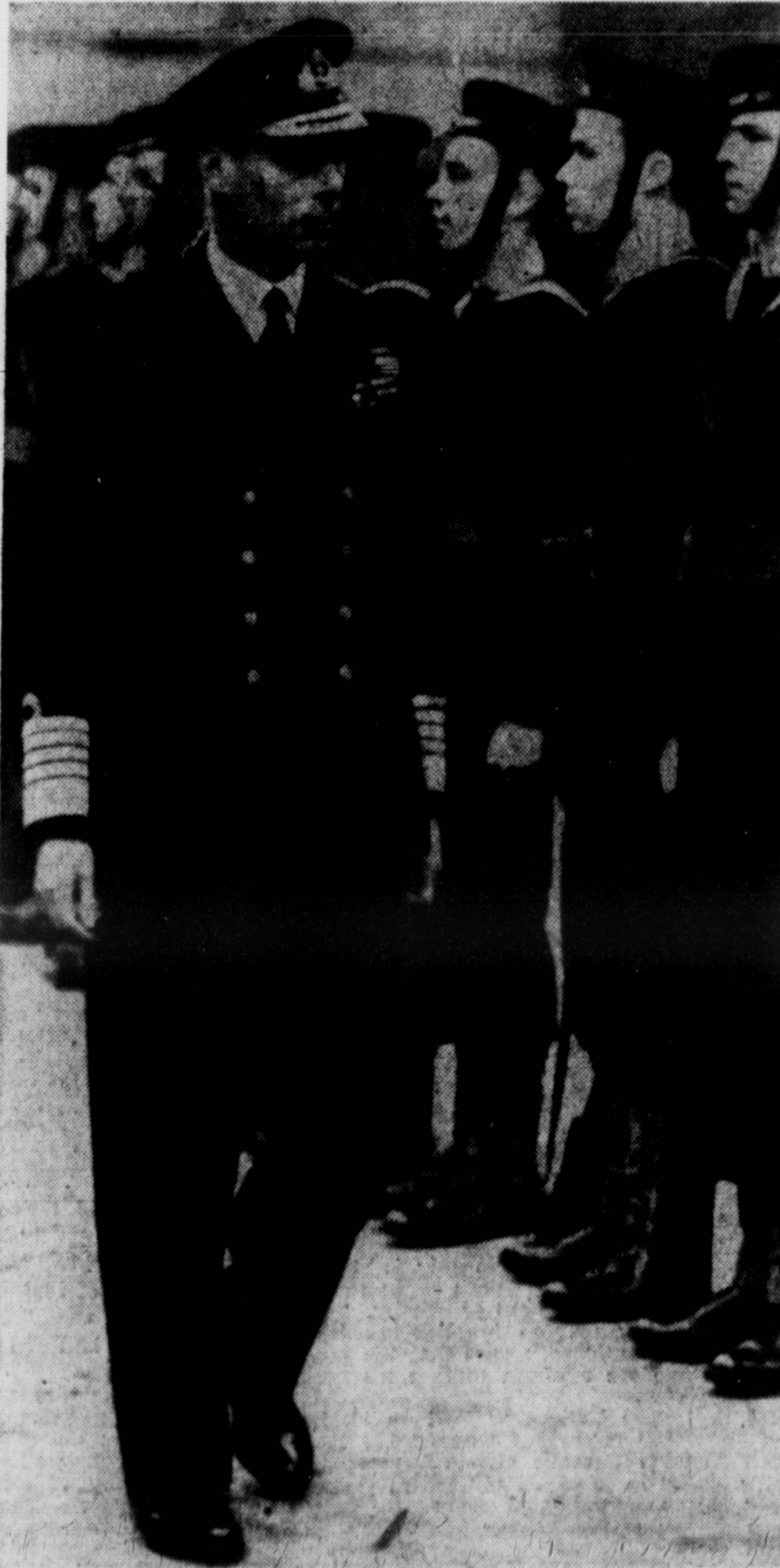
