Copper Notes. We clip the following mining news from this week's Torch Lake Times: The lowest level in the Kearsarge is reported looking like a jeweler's shop—shining with copper.

Sixty-seven cars of copper rock were hoisted through No. 2 shaft Tamarack last Saturday. This shaft will soon become an important factor in making the mine's product.

Something new has been uncovered at the Atlantic. It may or may not be the Quincy lode, but it carries a little copper and to determine its value we hear a shaft will be sunk.

The south ground in Allouez is showing some improvement for copper. Now that the new compressor is going the mine will probably be run with much more vigor.

The bottom of No. 5 Calumet is said to be showing a splendid lode, which is generally thought to be encouraging for Tamarack Junior. By the way, it was rumored again last week that the conglomerate was struck in No. 1 Tamarack Jr. The time is coming and not so very far in the future when a like rumor will prove true.

We shall soon see what the "dower" knows about the hidden wealth at the Allouez in the Calumet conglomerate. He said the lode will open out showing well for copper and that the shaft is 35 feet off the lode. The cross-out must be in about the requisite length to reach the bonanza according to the prediction of the man with the hazel boughs.

Rialto, in the Boston Advertiser, thinks John Stanton, of New York, the most conservative of men, and says that he is bullish on copper, having sold considerable at 17. The visible supply in Europe is 68,000 tons, 40,000 tons of which are in the hands of Baron Hirsch. Mr. Stanton believes in higher prices for the metal and has none to sell under 17.
