The People and Reforms.

The people cannot control nominations to public office. That is now a well known fact. The primaries in precincts near and remote are dominated by small cliques, in ways that are dark, and by tricks that would give the "heathen Chinese" considerable instruction. So far as this being a government of the people at the primaries, that is nonsense. It is not. The people are played like pawns on the chess-board. The primaries are a government of the clique or the machine as against another machine or clique.

And the same is true as to the county conventions. These conventions are made up of the results of the primaries. The same clique or machine has its unseen fingers on the wires. The county convention votes to adopt the slate. This is the long and the short of it. The clique which makes the slate, which prints the ballots, which furnishes the badges and the bands, these are the despots of the convention, and the people have no more to say than if they were dumb.

The same is true in the State convention. Here the machine or the clique is on the throne, and his two scepters are insinuation in the one hand and threats in the other. He has behind him the votes of the primaries and the county conventions; and with his bands, banners, committees, tools, favorites, he is boss of the state convention also. Is there anything like the voice of the people audible in this? The people are dumb. The only respect in which they have any power up to this point is the fear of the machine to tread upon them.

But have the people then no power? Are the people dumb-driven cattle? Have they no voice, but to bark at the command of their masters? Is our talk about the government of the people an iridescent illusion? Far from it. We are a government of the people. The people are the rulers. The clique or

Then what? Then, and not till then, but always then, it faces the people. Then comes the people's chance. Not one particle of obligation has yet been assumed by the people. The people have not yet been appealed to. The cliques and machines at this moment report to the people. Now is the moment when the clique or the machine is before the judgement seat. What the people then do is their part in determining what the government of the people intends shall be done. A machine is not the party. The party is the people. To say that the machine is the party is to say that the people are political slaves. Who wishes to wear that brand on his brain? It may be necessary, it sometimes is necessary, for the people in their efforts to rebuke the clique or machine, that the machine and the clique may be made to feel the weight of the people, and that the people have still the right and ability to govern themselves, and to demand that their principles be attended to and not trampled in the dust. The people have the sacred right to veto the clique or the machine, and, if they wish their voice to be the voice of God, when or where the necessity arises, they will do so.
