Success of Free Rural Mail Delivery.

Whether free rural mail delivery can be made to pay the cost of maintenance or not its success as a practical extension of the postal service has been demonstrated beyond all controversy.

No department of the federal service has had such phenomenal growth or such prompt manifestations of popular appreciation. A Washington dispatch to The Record-Herald recalls the fact that the first appropriation to inaugurate this experiment, which was only \$10,000, was made five years ago.

On the first of next month there will be 6,000 routes in operation, one carrier to each route, and each carrier serving an average of 600 persons.

As an agency for the dissemination of popular intelligence in rural communities and for promot-

ing the good road movement free rural mail delivery is one of the most gratifying achievements of the decade and merits all possible encouragement.

The Postoffice Department should insist on a high standard of post roads as a condition precedent to the extension of the free rural delivery.
