STORAGE OF ROOTS.

The time of the year is here when the farmer must prepare to store his roots for winter use.

While of course a cold storage house is the desirable thing, yet to many farmers this is an impossible opportunity.

For the reason that most farms are so far from a cold storage plant that it would not pay to haul the roots there.

Besides, the farmer frequently wants to store roots that he intends to use himself in feeding stock or for household consumption later on.

In our first illustration we give a method used in Nebraska for the purpose of insulating the roots.

The pile of roots is about four feet wide and the pile of dirt over them is six inches in thickness.

Above the first layer of earth is a layer of six inches of straw, and before cold weather comes on two inches more of dirt are put on.

The hole shown at V is a ventilating hole one foot in diameter. This kind of a pit is reported to do very well in Nebraska.
