Germans' 76-Mile Cannon Kills 75 in Paris Church in Good Friday Bombardment

 PARIS, March 29.—Seventy-five persons were killed and 90 wounded, most of them women and children, when a shell fired by a German long-range gun fell on a church in the region of Paris while Good Friday services were being held, according to an official communication issued this evening. Among those killed was H. Stroehlin, counselor of the Irish Legation in Paris. The same church was struck by a shell during the celebration of high mass last Sunday and many casualties resulted.
