**Husband Convinced White Wife Left To Avoid Hurting Him**

NORWOOD, N. J.—A Negro engineer has returned home from Florida convinced his missing white wife is afraid to return with their three children because of the hurt she has caused him.

Jean A. Brown, 35, a merchant marine engineer, went to Tampa earlier this week after receiving information that his white wife Louise, 34, was working as a waitress in a local diner and living at a trailer camp.

Brown, who has offered a \$1,000 reward for information leading to his wife's whereabouts, said he concluded that his wife left Tampa "definitely... under duress and fatigue." He said he was convinced she won't return now because of the hurt she has caused

him.  
He said Mrs. Brown left Tampa Monday night a few hours before he arrived. She fled "like a scared deer with her brood," he said.

Brown said his wife left their home here April 25th with their three children and \$1,800 because of "mental depression" and threatening and slanderous telephone calls because of our mixed marriage.

fecting Africa may be brought about in an "orderly peaceful manner."

He said that President Sekou Toure had instructed him to express Guinea's gratitude for the U. S.' friendly attitude upon Guinea's obtaining independence and its admission to the United Nations.

Guinea chose freedom when French Premier DeGaulle made his celebrated tour of French colonies and put the question to all of the countries.

Immediately after his country's decision, Toure entered into an agreement with Ghana to form the nucleus of what he and Ghana's Prime Minister Nkrumah hope will be a United States of Africa. In addition, Ghana lent Guinea 10 million pounds, repayment of which will begin in 1964 and on which the new nation this year begins payment of interest of two percent at half-yearly intervals.

In his reply to Ambassador Diallo's remarks, President Eisenhower said he attached "deep significance" to the forging of "another bond" between Guinea and the United States. He referred to this country's recognition of Guinea's independence and its support of admission to the UN.

Eisenhower also expressed the wish that the "interdependence of free nations in a changing world" will be strengthened.


