The city farmer down the road says one good thing about livin' on a farm is that you can quarrel with your wife once in a while without all the neighbors hearin'.

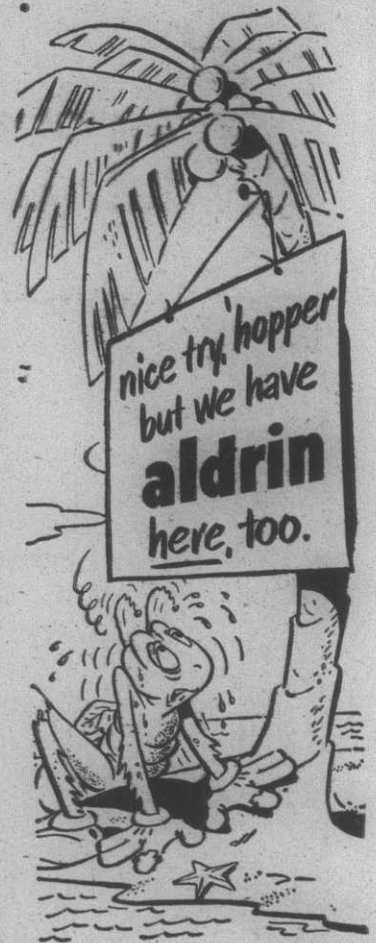
