under expanding new crop supplies, while oats and barley will be about steady. After a few weeks, prices for all feed grains probably will turn stronger but gains are likely to be slow.

FLAXSEED—The crop estimate has been raised to 30 million bushels, up 7.2 million from last year, but because of the light carryover, total supplies remain small compared with requirements. Prices probably will show a little seasonal strength in the next two or three months.

DAIRY PRODUCTS—Seasonal price strength will continue through the next six to eight weeks. Under new legislation price supports were raised 3 cents a pound for butterfat and 16 cents a cwt. for manufacturing milk until March 31, 1961. CCC's buying prices were upped 2½ cents a pound for butter, 1½ cents for cheese and ½ cent for nonfat dry milk. Prices have been above supports recently. The change in support level will reduce the seasonal price drop from early winter to late spring.

EGGS—Prices for fine large eggs are rounding the peak for the year and will start a seasonal decline in two to four weeks, but are likely to average substantially higher during most of the next six months than a year earlier. The number of potential layers on Sept. 1 was 7 per cent less than a year previous and smallest for that date in the 24-year record. However, production per layer is 2-3 per cent over a year ago.

POTATOES—Prices in the next few weeks will be under pressure from heavy harvest-time marketing. Forecasts of late summer and fall crops total 203.4 million cwt., up 5.1 million from last year. However, table use is holding nearly steady and use by processors for products other than starch and flour has been increasing 5 or 6 million cwt. a year.

BEANS—Adjustment of prices to a new crop basis is about completed. They probably will hold fairly steady through early fall. Any rise is likely to be moderate and may not be much more than the cost of storing. The crop forecast was increased to 17.7 million cwt. against 18.2 million last year.

Light-Weight Wheat Eligible for Support

PRICE-SUPPORT REGULATIONS on 1960-crop wheat have been relaxed to include light-weight wheat that previously was ineligible for support, Gaspard W. Deschamps, Missoula, chairman of the State Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation committee, announces. The change has been made because prolonged drought in some areas is resulting in a higher percentage of light-weight wheat than usual.

Under the relaxed regulation, wheat grading "Sample" on test weight only will now be eligible for support, but no wheat testing less than 40 pounds per bushel will be eligible. Before the provisions were relaxed, price support was limited to wheat grading No. 3 or better, or No. 4 or No. 5 on test weight only.

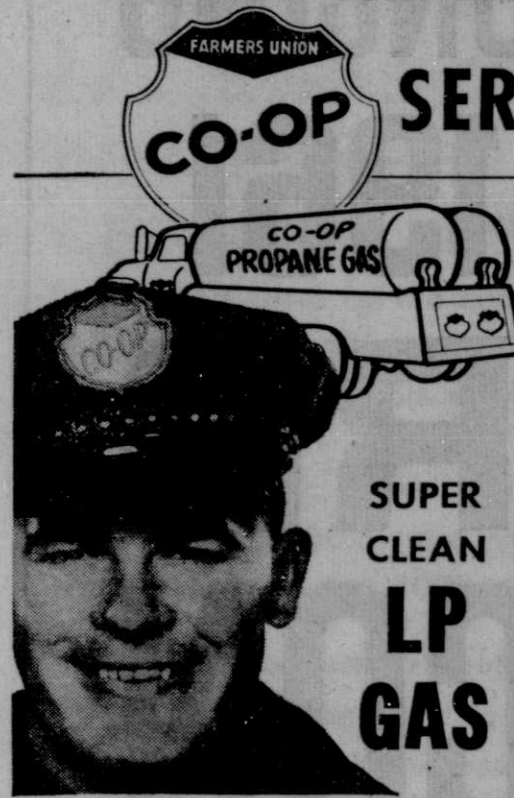
The light-weight wheat will be discounted below the minimum test weight (50 or 51 pounds a bushel, depending on class) for Grade No. 5 wheat at the rate of 4 cents for each pound through 45 pounds per bushel and 6 cents for each pound thereafter for wheat having a test weight of 40 through 44 pounds per bushel. This discount will be in addition to other required discounts and will be added to the discount of 9 cents per bushel for wheat grading No. 5 on test weight.
