COOLING SYSTEMS

The internal combustion engine is a heat engine in which power is developed by converting the heat energy generated through the combustion of fuel into mechanical energy. Therefore it would seem wasteful to have a cooling system for dissipating a portion of the heat of combustion; however, in order to control the temperature of the combustion chamber to prevent pre-ignition, warping of the valves, loss of power through lower volumetric efficiency, excessive piston expansion and rapid breakdown of the lubricating oil film, especially on the cylinder walls and pistons, it is necessary to dissipate approximately 33 per cent to 40 per cent of the total heat of combustion.

Therefore it is most important that your cooling system be clean and that it be checked regularly.

During the winter time the use of anti-freeze necessitates a complete flushing out of the entire cooling system—your service station and garage operator will be pleased to attend to these details.

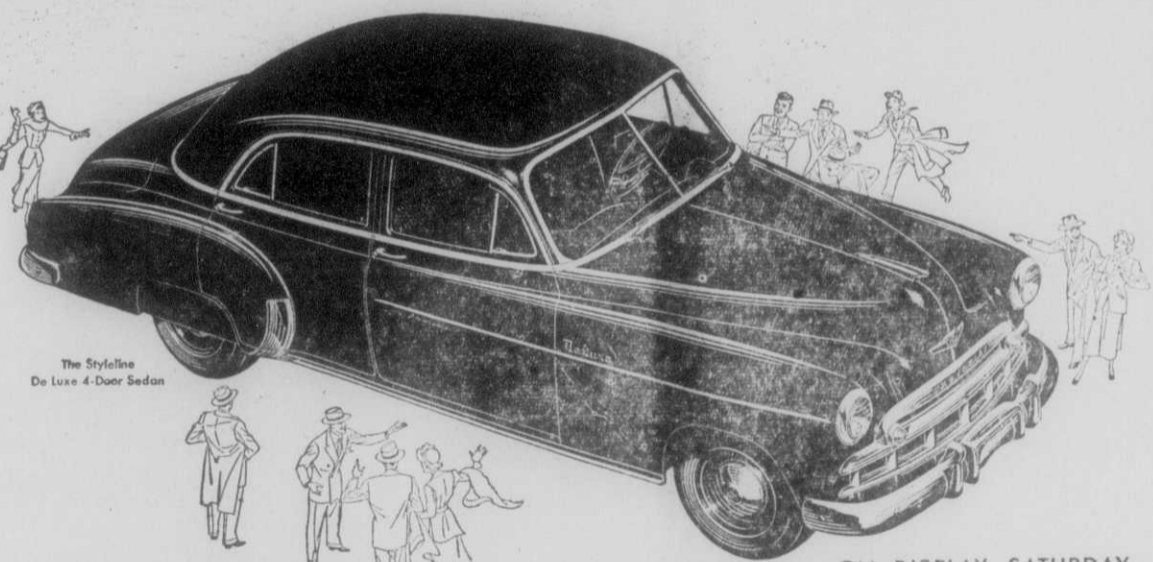
