Fire Destroys Ranch Home

Fire of unknown origin the afternoon of May 1, burned the ranch home of Mrs. Anne Cummings on Lake Creek near Troy. The fire started in the back shed about 3:30 entirely destroying the 9-room residence.

Mrs. Cummings and daughter, Belle with two babies were alone when the fire was discovered. A son, Frank drove out from Troy immediately after the alarm was phoned in, but was unable to save more than a few chairs, the piano and a couple of trunks which were in the front of the house. With the aid of forest service pumps the cellar and barn were saved. There was no insurance on the house.

Mrs. Cummings was selling the place and had expected in another two weeks to move to Troy. The deal was to have been concluded May 15.
