Libby, Montana June 3, 1946
The Board of County Commissioners of Lincoln County, met in regular session in the courthouse at Libby, at 10:00 A. M., June 3, 4, 5, 1946.
Present were: P. V. Klinke, Chairman, James Mahoney and Chet O. Hoisington, Commissioners, and G. C. Earle, Clerk of the Board.
Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.
A delegation composed of Charles L. Bump, J. W. Stoken and Zelmar Moses, with Mr. Jones, County Agent for Flathead County, met with the Commissioners for the purpose of discussing a weed control program and also the employment of a full time County Agent.
Decision on the matter was deferred until the regular meeting in July at the time the next budget is made up.
