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not outstanding, including two that were dry holes. Others are acidizing shows.

Of the locations, one is of exceptional interest. This is O. A. Nepstad's wildcat on a federal lease held for years by Wendell G. Baum, aiming at a northwest extension of the field. The well, now spudding, is in C SW NE NW 3-35N-3W. It is of interest in that the southern edge of the 40 acres on which it is situated, adjoins the north edge of a block for which the Standard of California paid \$400,000 in the early days of the field, and then abandoned. That was before the days of acid and apparently many of the Standard's wells, abandoned with only shows of oil, might have been commercial had they been drilled today and acidized.
