**ROAD WORKERS DEMAND INCREASE**

**County Commissioners Declare Union Scale Higher than the Law Allows.**

The Workingmen's union wants more wages for the men employed by the county, according to a request made by the business agent of the organization to the county commissioners today. The men employed by the county, except those engaged in road work, have been receiving \$3.75 a day, and it was the intention of the commissioners to increase the pay to \$4 a day. The business agent asked that the wages be increased to \$4.25 a day, the union scale. The commissioners called attention to the fact that the men employed on road work could not be paid more than \$4 a day according to law, and promised to take the question of the increase of other employes under consideration. The road workers have been getting \$4. That the Metal Mine Workers' union intends making an effort to close the independent mines which are still operating has come to light through a resolution passed by the union yesterday. In this resolution the Campbell union declares unfair all employees of mining labor in the Summit Valley district, which takes in Butte and portions of Silver Bow county. **WILL NOT LEVY A TAX ON LETTERS**

**Senate by a Vote of 39 to 29 Strikes Out Provision in Amendment.**

Washington, Aug. 28.—In resuming consideration today of postage sections of the war tax bill the senate, by a vote of 39 to 29, struck out the provision levying a one-cent tax on letters and post cards designed to raise \$50,000,000 in revenue. A provision giving American soldiers and sailors abroad the privilege of mailing letters free was retained. Eight amendments to the war tax bill providing for levies on war profits ranging from 75 down to 48 per cent were introduced today by Senator La Follette. The entire section levying taxes on first-class mail was eliminated on motion of Senator Hardwick of Georgia. The senate then proceeded to the periodical tax provision. Senator Smoot announced he would seek later to reconsider elimination of the letter tax section. Senator La Follette said he would offer the amendment for the highest, 78 per cent rate, and if it was rejected, would ask consideration of the next in order until one was accepted. The bill as it now stands would make an average tax of 26 per cent.

**LIVING WAS HIGH IN THE OLD DAYS**

**I. B. Hopkins, Who Came Here in 1864, Renewing Old Acquaintances.**

I. B. Hopkins, a veteran mining man, who came to this part of the country in 1864, is about the city shaking hands with the old-timers. Although 72 years of age, Mr. Hopkins would easily pass for a man much younger. Up to a few months ago Mr. Hopkins was superintendent of the Boston and Montana Development company, which is carrying on extensive work in the Elkhorn district and in which he holds a large block of stock. Feeling that he was entitled to a rest, Mr. Hopkins retired from the position and was succeeded by John D. Pope, formerly manager of the North Butte company. Mr. Hopkins, in addition to his holdings in the Boston and Montana Development company, has extensive interests in mining properties in Alaska, which are turning out very profitably. Mr. Hopkins was one of the early prospectors in the Alder Gulch, and he wears as a breastpin a fine gold nugget made from the yellow metal he found himself in that district. **Michaelis and His Methods Do Not Appeal to Some Newspapers.**

Copenhagen, Aug. 28.—The possibility of another change in the imperial chancellery in Germany is discussed by George Bernhard in the Vossische Zeitung. He says that it is plainly evident that the appointment of a minor official like Dr. Michaelis, without general political experience, was a grave mistake. Parliament, he argues, must take the matter of internal reforms and peace into its own hands. Theodore Wolff of the Tageblatt dismisses the new budget-reichstag committee as a "nostrum" designed to soothe the cry of the German people for popular control of the government. **WAR MINISTER BLAMED FOR LEAK TO BERLIN**

**Petrograd Secrets Found Way Quickly to the Foe is Testimony.**

Petrograd, Aug. 28.—At the trial for high treason of General Soukhomlinoff, former minister of war, General Ivanoff, former commander in Volhynia and Galicia, testified yesterday he had information showing that military secrets had been communicated direct from Petrograd to Germany and Austria by way of Warsaw. General Velitchko, deputy director of the engineer corps, said he regarded General Soukhomlinoff as having been principally responsible for the defeats of the Russian army. As soon as he was appointed minister of war, the witness testified, he suppressed various councils created for the purpose of discussing questions of national defense. Former Emperor Nicholas, General Velitchko said, should not be held responsible for the military misfortunes of Russia, as he saw everything through the spectacles of General Soukhomlinoff. He had reasons for side-tracking parliamentary reform until after the war and says that the truth is that parliamentarism is not desired just now because it would impose restrictions on the government and end the domination of secret influences.
